Nosara Tours

Mangrove SUP or Kayak Tour

This tour starts at Nosara River mouth, which offers amazing views. You will row on Montaña river which runs parallel to the ocean, during a one hour ride you can spot different types of birds and if you are lucky even a crocodile. Along the way our guide will provide information about wildlife and Nosara's biodiversity. Approximately one hour after starting the tour, there is a stop to visit Nosara beach that can only be accessed by water, you will have the entire beach for yourself while enjoying fruit and coconut water snacks. The river's calm water allows this activity to be suitable for all ages and physical conditions. Available in kayak or stand up paddle boards.

Duration: 2.5 - 3 hrs Depending on the tides

Includes: Guide, Round Trip Transportation + Snack + Drink *Additional Transportation costs apply if out of Nosara Area

What To Bring: Swimsuit, towel, Sunscreen, insect repellent, Hat and waterproof camera.

Wildlife And Waterfall Adventure Hike

The Mala Noche waterfall is known in Nosara for its beauty and easy access. You will enjoy a nice walk following the river on a property with a lush garden. The guide will give you information regarding medicinal and ornamental plants. After a 45 minutes walk you arrive at the waterfall where you can cool off in freshwater, swim or just relax by the clear water. Explore climbing the rocks to find a second and third smaller waterfalls. This activity is available during the rainy season, between June and December, and the first three months of the dry season. For a year round waterfall tour see our Pilas Blancas Waterfall ATV tour. Duration including transportation is 3 hours.

Birdwatching Hike

For this tour you get to choose to do the hike at Nosara's Biological Reserve or at the beautiful property around Mala Noche Waterfall. In both locations you can see a wide variety of terrestrial and aquatic bird species. Our guide will provide information about amazing birds and nature along the way. Experienced bird watchers will also learn from local birds and will have the chance to get nice pictures.

Duration: 2.5 - 3 hrs Recommend 6am pick up when wildlife is more active but it can be done any time during the day.

ATV Tour To San Juanillo Beach With Snorkeling

San Juanillo Beach is a gorgeous bay in a little fishermen village. Have fun driving on a dirt road and crossing rivers while looking at farms, cows and ocean views. Once in San Juanillo you can do snorkeling, swim in the ocean or just relax.

Duration: 3 - 3.5 hrs 8:30 am to 3:30 pm

Includes: Guide, Round Trip Transportation, safety equipment + Snack + Drink **Additional Transportation costs apply if out of Nosara Area*

What To Bring: Clothes you don't mind getting dirty, Swimsuit, towel, Teva or water shoes for low river crossings, Sunscreen, insect repellent and waterproof camera.

ATV Mountain Tour

This tour will take you to the mountains above Nosara, enjoying beautiful views. Experience the adrenaline of driving an ATV up the mountain on the different types of terrains in this area. One hour later you reach Pilas Blancas, where you can enjoy the beautiful waterfall surrounded by pure nature, a tropical fruit snack and coconut water.

Duration: 3 - 4 hrs 8:30 am to 3:30pm

ATV + Coffee Tour

Naranjal is a small town in the mountains above Nosara (45 min). The views of the ocean, mountains and rural life will make the ride a rich and colorful experience. Once at our destination you will walk around a coffee plantation learning about coffee and how it is processed. From picking to roasting, you can actively participate in the processes. Experience the rural way of life grinding corn for your tortillas, sip on a fresh cup of coffee while waiting for your typical Costa Rican meal to be served (breakfast or lunch). Car transportation available if you wish not to ride an ATV.

Duration: 3 - 3.5 hrs 8:30 am to 3:30pm

Snorkeling San Juanillo by Car

Playa San Juanillo is one of the most spectacular beaches of Costa Rica. This beach is divided by a rock formation into two small bays. Both beaches are very different, one is more sandy and the other has more reefs and rocks perfect for snorkeling and observing colorful tropical fish. The ride to San Juanillo takes 45 minutes, once at the beach you can enjoy a nice walk, snorkeling, relaxing at the beach and a fruit and coconut water snack.

Duration: 3.5 - 4 hrs 8:30 am to 3:30pm

Includes: Guide, Round Trip Transportation + Snack + Drink **Additional Transportation costs apply if out of Nosara Area*

What To Bring: Swimsuit, towel, Sunscreen, insect repellent, Hat and waterproof camera.

Turtle Nesting At Ostional

This tour takes place at the beautiful Ostional Beach, which is internationally known as a wildlife sanctuary where thousands of olive ridley turtles come each year to nest. In this place you can learn more about these beautiful creatures, and witness both the birth of the baby turtles as well as their arrival to nest at the beach (depending on the date). Take into account that the sighting of nesting turtles is usually at night and the birth is early in the morning. This tour operates throughout the year, please contact us to know if they are in nesting or hatching season during your stay in Nosara to verify that the tour can be carried out.

Turtle hatching tour: 5:00AM (mornings only)

Turtle nesting tour: 5:00PM (afternoons only)

Duration: 2 -3 hrs

Horseback Riding

Beach Tour: This tour is the perfect opportunity to explore the area and of course add another check to your bucket list. The tour begins at Playa Ponies, we will start on the jungle trails that flank the Nosara River then pass through the wildlife reserve on our way down to the Boca and catch our first glimpse of the ocean, next we will pass through another jungle trail up and over to Playa Pelada, then head over to Playa Guiones the local surf beach. The tour is not over yet, Pura Vida is the local saying here. Let us know if you want to customize your tour to include a stop to gelato or perhaps a cerveza on the beach.

Mountain Tour: On the mountain tour you follow trails on a cattle farm where cows and bulls walk freely on the Guanacaste Pampa

Duration: 2.5 - 3hrs 8:30 am to 3:30 pm

Includes: Guide, Round Trip Transportation, Helmet + Snack + Drink **Additional Transportation costs apply if out of Nosara Area*

Surfing Instruction

During the theoretical part of our surf lessons we focus on water safety, which we consider essential. Also we go over the ethics of surfing, paddling techniques and techniques to duck under the wave. It is important that beginners have all this information before going to the water. Once in the ocean it is time to have fun and apply what you just learned. If you are an intermediate or advanced surfer we focus on improving your technique and of course help you have fun on bigger waves.

SUP Surf Instruction

In the activity of Stand Up Paddle Surf we focus on water safety, which we consider essential, the ethics of surfing, rowing techniques and introduction to the Sup Surf for beginners, intermediate and advanced.

Canyoning ("MALA NOCHE" WATERFALL)

Turtle Tour-Camaronal o Corozalito:

You will ride with a driver/guide to either Corozalito Beach or Camaronal Beach towards the South from Samara or if there is an arribada in Ostional Beach, the tour will be changed for no additional cost. Arribadas are when thousands of turtles come to shore to lay eggs. This happens once a month from 3 to 4 days after the last quarter phase of the moon. Your guide will explain all the safety procedures and will give the corresponding instructions of the tour. The experienced guide will walk you through the beach in search of the turtles. During the tour, the guide will provide information and you can ask for drinks such as water and juices while you look at the surroundings. Enjoy some fruit as a snack on the way back to your hotel.
